

THE LOGAN WOOD MEMORIAL FISHING TOURNAMENT RULES

Virtual Captain's Meeting

Tournament rules and regulations are subject to change at any time through the completion of the Virtual Captain's Meeting on **Thursday**, **September 4th**, **2025**. Anglers are responsible for staying current on all rules and regulations through the completion of the tournament itself.

Virtual Captain's Meeting, held on **September 4th, 2025** is mandatory for each registered Angler; Zoom link will be provided to attend virtually.

This is an Angler Tournament. All anglers must be paid and registered prior to **9 pm on September 4th, 2025**. There will be **NO REFUND OF ENTRY FEES** (Tournament committee is responsible for any changes to this under certain circumstances).

A completed entry includes the registration form, fees, and waiver. Failure to submit all three prior to or at the captain's meeting will result in rejection of entry and inability to participate.

Fishing Dates & Times

The one fishing day is Saturday, September 6, 2025. THERE IS NO RAIN DAY.

Fishing starts at 12:01 am Saturday, September 6, 2025. No lines in water prior to this time.

It is up to the discretion of the registered angler to determine whether his or her craft (if fishing

from boat) is seaworthy for existing sea conditions. Participants are encouraged to keep abreast of any marine or weather warnings.

Tournament VH channel will be #72.

Eligible Species

Flounder | Trout | Sheepshead | Redfish |

All fish must be caught on the day of the tournament by rod and reel, cane pole, fly rod, or hand line only.

Artificial or natural bait may be used.

No nets, dynamite or guns, etc.

No rotten or mutilated fish will be weighed. Eligible fish may be caught by land, boat or Kayak.

Minimum Qualifying Sizes

Spottail Bass (Red Fish, Red Drum, Channel Bass) 15"-23". Under the new SC guidelines, Red Drum are to be measured using the pinched tail method

Trout (Spotted Seatrout, Winter Trout) 14" minimum

Flounder (Summer or Southern) 16" minimum

Sheepshead 14" minimum

It is highly recommended that you measure your fish prior to presenting it for weigh in. The weigh master will conduct the weigh in and make all decisions concerning the legality of the submitted fish.

WEIGH IN

Tournament Weigh Station Location: Ambrose Home, 2414 Rockland Avenue, Rockville. Tournament weigh-in hours are 3 – 5 pm.

Fish to be weighed may be brought in by car and there will be limited dock space.

WINNINGS

Prizes are awarded solely based on fish weight. In the event of identical weights, the first fish weighed shall be declared the winner.

The Honor System applies throughout the entire tournament.

The Junior Angler must be 14 years old or younger (as of September 6, 2025). This prize is based on the single heaviest fish weighed.

The Lady Angler must be female and 15 years old or older (as of September 6, 2025). This prize is based on the single heaviest fish weighed.

If there should be a dispute of any kind the decision of the Tournament Committee will be final.
